Dear Village Resident,

In the past year there have been significant infrastructure improvements in the Village. After several years of diligent effort by the Village Board of Trustees, with the help of letters and phone calls from residents and the support of Chief Smith of the Old Brookville Police Department, we were able to have Nassau County repave the County roads in our Village.

We did an extensive assessment of the street lighting in the Village. Our goals were to provide lighting that is appropriate to the nature of our village, limit light pollution, and be eco-friendly. To that end, we have installed environmentally-friendly, efficient LED fixtures at intersections and dangerous curves. These handsome new fixtures enhance the appearance of the Village, will be less costly to operate, and will require less maintenance.

Still to come...

In cooperation with the Village of Mill Neck, the County has agreed to install a three-way stop sign at the intersection of Duck Pond Road and Bayville/Oyster Bay Road.

Outside of our Village but of benefit to us all, the County has agreed to install a traffic light at the intersection of Hegeman's Lane and Route 107. This signal is to be synchronized with the Chicken Valley Road and 25A lights to ease traffic congestion.

These are all significant accomplishments which will improve the beauty and safety of our community.
