A public hearing and meeting will be held before and by the Board of Trustee of the Incorporated Village of Matinecock, Nassau County, New York, at the Portledge School, Upper School Library, 355 Duck Pond Road, in said Village, on Tuesday, May 21, 2024 at 6:30 p.m.

The hearing will be on the application of Extenet Systems, LLC, requesting to modify four (4) existing Wireless Facilities within the Village of Matinecock's right-of-way on existing wooden utility poles. The existing sites currently have multiple carriers including T-Mobile. To facilitate the equipment upgrade, the existing equipment at the site must be enlarged. The current facility's equipment consists of a 47" x 22" x 12" shroud on the side of the pole and a 23.2" x 12.1" x 7" antenna on top of the pole. The new equipment will consist of a 55" x 36" x 20" shroud which is placed on the side of the pole and will be swapping out the existing antenna with a new antenna but matching the same size of the existing site. The proposed modification and upgrade of existing wireless facility noted above is an eligible facilities request for a minor modification under Section 64091 and the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC").2 Under Section 6409, it allows for the facility's approval if it does not substantially change the physical dimensions of a facility. All four (4) telecommunication facilities will be within the Village's public right of way at the following four (4) locations:

- 1. North side of Chicken Valley Road, 2 poles West of Wolver Hollow Road. Immediately adjacent to Section 23 Block B Lot 468.
- 2. 700 Chicken Valley Road. Immediately adjacent to Section 23 Block B Lot 473.
- 3. 540 Chicken Valley Road. Immediately adjacent to Section 23 Block B Lot 496.
- 4. North side of Chicken Valley Road, 6 poles east of Locust Lane. Immediately adjacent to Section 23 Block B Lot 3.

The above application is on file at the office of Humes & Wagner, LLP, attorneys for the Village, 147 Forest Avenue, Locust Valley, New York where it may be seen during the regular hours of the usual business days until the time of the hearing.
